Students scoring below the 40<sup>th</sup> percentile can be considered at some risk for poor literacy outcomes. Students scoring below the 20<sup>th</sup> percentile can be considered at risk. Note that the 40<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> percentile points are recommendations but not firm cutpoints.
