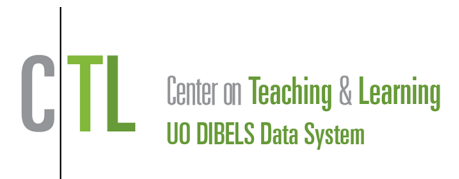

Students scoring below the 40th percentile can be considered at some risk for poor mathematics outcomes. Students scoring below the 20th percentile can be considered at risk. Note that the 40th and 20th percentile points are recommendations but not firm cutpoints.

The national percentile (NP) numbers included on this report were generated using a nationally representative sample of 10,525 students during a 2009-2010 research study.
