Internal Consistency of the easyCBM©

CCSS Math Measures:

Grades K-8

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Abstract

This technical report documents findings from a study of the internal consistency and split-half reliability of the easyCBM© CCSS Math measures, grades K-8. Data, drawn from an extant data set gathered in School Year 2013-2014, include scores from over 130,000 students' fall and winter benchmark assessments. Findings suggest that the easyCBM© CCSS Math measures are internally consistent, with a median Cronbach's alpha of .90, and a median split-half reliability of .80 (first half) and .86 (second half) across all 18 measures analyzed.

Internal Consistency of the easyCBM© CCSS Math Measures, Grades K-8

Mathematics measures specifically written to assess students' mastery of the Common Core State Standards (CCSS) were added to the easyCBM© benchmarking and progress monitoring system in 2014, as part of a larger effort to expand the reading and mathematics assessments available on the system. Detailed information about the development process can be found in a series of technical reports written by Saven, Irvin, Park, Alonzo, Anderson, and Tindal (2013a, 2013b), Irvin, Saven, Alonzo, Park, Anderson and Tindal (2013a, 2013b), Saven, Irvin, Park, Alonzo, Anderson, and Tindal (2013a, 2013b), and Anderson, Alonzo, and Tindal (2013). All easyCBM© CCSS math items were written by teachers and district mathematics specialists, under the guidance of experienced assessment developers at the University of Oregon. All 13 test forms at each grade level were written to be of equivalent difficulty. In the current study, we used extant data from the easyCBM© database to analyze the internal consistency and split-half reliability of the easyCBM© CCSS measures across all grades where they are offered.

Methods

Participants

The study was conducted using values from the fall and winter 2013-2014 CCSS math benchmark assessments. The fall benchmark was taken by 9,360 kindergarteners; 18,911 grade 1 students; 20,910 grade 2 students; 18,356 grade 3 students; 18,229 grade 4 students; 18,652 grade 5 students; 11,860 grade 6 students; 10,384 grade 7 students; and 8,961 grade 8 students for a total of 135,893 participants. The winter benchmark was taken by 14,158 kindergarteners; 20,448 grade 1 students; 22,441 grade 2 students; 20,807 grade 3 students; 20,031 grade 4 students; 19,446 grade 5 students; 11,919 grade 6

students; 10,116 grade 7 students; and 9,254 grade 8 students for a total of 148,640 participants.

Students of American Indian or Alaskan Native descent comprised 1-4% of the sample, and Asian students made up 2-3% of the sample across all grades. Black or African American students made up 10-19% of the sample in grade K-2 and 3-5% of the sample in grade 3-8. Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander students made up 0-1% and students identified as Two or more Races constituted 1-2% of the sample across all grades. Lastly, White students made up 44-55% of the sample, and those classified as Unknown ethnicity made up 29-47% of the sample across all grades.

Similarly, students identified as Hispanic/Latino made up 8-16% of the sample and students identified as Not Hispanic/Latino made up 48-70% of the sample, varying by grade level. The percentage of ELL students in the sample had a range of 16-33%. Students identified by their districts as disabled constituted 17-31% of the sample. Males made up 49-53% of the sample. Complete demographic data can be found in Tables 1-3.

Measures

The fall and winter benchmark versions of the easyCBM© CCSS math measures for grades K through 8 were used for this study. Due to the time of year in which the data were gathered, only fall and winter benchmark measures were included in this study.

Kindergarten measures had a total of 30 points possible, grades 1 and 2 had a total of 35 points possible, and grades 3 through 5 and 6 through 8 had a potential of 40 and 45 points possible, respectively. The development of the measures for each grade (K-5 individually and 6-8 combined) is described in detail in their respective technical reports (Anderson, Alonzo, & Tindal, 2013; Irvin, Saven, Alonzo, Park, Anderson, & Tindal, 2013 a, b, &

c; Saven, Irvin, Park, Alonzo, Anderson, & Tindal, 2013 a, b, & c). As the technical reports document, the alternate forms of the measures within each grade (both benchmark and progress monitoring forms) were designed to be of equivalent difficulty, using a systematic and tightly controlled development plan. Thus, although this study used data only from fall and winter benchmark assessments, the results should generalize to the other forms.

Data preparation and analysis

Prior to analysis, students who had not responded to any items on a particular math measure were removed from the dataset. Next, the data were examined for scoring irregularities, and any out-of-range values were removed. One 5th grade student from the winter benchmark was removed due to a score being not within the possible range for the measure.

The measures were analyzed for internal consistency using Cronbach's Alpha and Split-half reliability (first half/second half) as well as item level statistics of the top and bottom 27th percentiles. For the split-half reliability, the measures were analyzed using the first half to the median compared to the second half. Further analysis of the data suggests the best reliability is achieved by retaining all items.

Results

Descriptive statistics for CCSS math can be found in Table 4. Table 5 and 6-20, respectively, document the internal consistency in the form of average inter-item reliability (Cronbach's Alpha), followed by split-half reliability and top / bottom reliability

Internal Consistency

CCSS math

The Cronbach's Alpha ranged from .81 to .95, with a median of .90 for all measures in both the fall and winter. As expected, all fall and winter measures for each grade were within .03 of one another, with most falling within .01. See table 5 for complete inter-item reliability data.

The split-half reliability ranged from .65 to .95 for the first and second half of the measures. The median for the first half was .80. It was .86 for the second half. The correlation between the two halves ranged from .52 to .73, with a median correlation of .67. See table 5 for complete split-half reliability data.

All items at all grade levels, but one, performed as expected with the higher percentile students getting the items correct more often than the lower percentile students. The one exception was item 9 of the 6th grade fall benchmark. Complete item-level statistics can be found in tables 6-23.

Discussion

Results of this study provide evidence in support of the internal consistency of the easyCBM© CCSS Math measures, across all grades K-8. Although only data from the Fall and Winter benchmark assessments were used in this study, the development process used for the measures, in which all alternate forms within a given grade level were designed to be of equivalent difficulty, and the consistent findings across all grades and forms analyzed suggests that the results may well generalize to the other easyCBM© CCSS Math forms, including the Spring benchmark tests and all ten progress monitoring forms at each grade level. It is also worth noting that the consistency of the findings across the fall and winter benchmark test forms add to the evidence of form equivalence reported in earlier technical reports documenting the development process used in the creation of the measures.
