Standardized Script	Wording is slightly different for all measures.
Standardized Examiner Prompts	 DIBELS 8 includes fewer acceptable prompts than previous versions. DIBELS 8 acceptable prompts are listed below. Letter Naming Fluency: If the student hesitates for three seconds: Slash the letter, say the letter name, point to the next letter, and say, "Keep going." (<i>Repeat as needed</i>) If the student says letter sounds instead of names: Say, "Remember to tell me the letter name, not its sound." (Use only once) Phonemic Segmentation Fluency: If the student hesitates for three seconds: Leave the word or remaining sounds in the word blank, and present the next word (<i>Repeat as needed</i>) Nonsense Word Fluency: If the student hesitates for three seconds: Mark the sound/word as incorrect, point to the next sound/word, and say: "Keep going." Do not provide the sound/word. (Repeat as needed) Oral Reading Fluency: If the student starts reading the passage out loud, say "Please read the passage silently." If the student skips pages, say "Please be sure not to skip pages." If the student stops working, say "Please keep going until I tell you to stop. Just do your best work."



Discontinue Benchmark Assessment Rules	 In addition to subtest discontinuation rules, DIBELS 8 includes the option to not administer the remaining benchmark subtests at certain circumstances and time points. Beginning of kindergarten: If PSF is discontinued, do not administer NWF and WRF. Middle of kindergarten: If NWF is discontinued, do not administer WRF. Beginning of first grade: If WRF is discontinued, do not administer
	ORF.
Nonsense Word Fluency Scoring	 Some Nonsense Word Fluency scoring rules have changed with DIBELS 8, compared to earlier versions. Correct words: Underline, and give WRC credit, for words read sound-by-sound and then as whole words. <i>*Key difference between DIBELS Next and DIBELS 8.</i> Sounds read out of order are slashed and counted as incorrect, <i>even</i> <i>if the student is pointing to the correct letter.</i> R-controlled vowels count as one phoneme in DIBELS 8. However, an r-controlled vowel read as two separate phonemes that does not distort the r-controlled vowel sound is marked as correct.
